Director: Andrew Cockroft-Penman

Following his studies in Theatre and Performance at the University of New England, Andrew's directing credits encompass musical theatre, cabaret, and Shakespeare. Notable productions include Little Shop of Horrors and Wizard of Oz for Players Theatre, Kiss Me, Kate! for GCLT, Popular Mechanicals, Woyzeck, and Sweeney Todd for UNE, Curtains for BTG, Government Inspector for Javeenbah, and Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor

Dreamcoat, Oliver!, and The Mystery of Edwin Drood for Spotlight Theatrical. Since founding Technicolour Theatre Company in 2018, Andrew has produced Peter Pan, Godspell, Romeo and Juliet, Pinocchio, and A Midsummer Night's Dream as the inaugural Gold Coast Shakespeare in the Park. His leadership extends to facilitating workshops that bridge emerging artists with industry leaders. In 2023, Andrew partnered with Undercover Artist Festival in tandem with Queensland Theatre, and Brisbane Festival for the development and premiere of Sleep and the City by Emma-June Curik at Bille Brown Theatre. Andrew's notable performances include Michael in Six Dance Lessons in Six Weeks, Khilestacov in The Government Inspector, Jack in Into the Woods, Barnaby Tucker in Hello, Dolly! and Peter in Company.



Musical Director: Steven Days

Steven currently works as the Performing Arts program Coordinator at a local Gold Coast school. Steven's passion for music started in NZ where in a past life, he worked professionally as a musician in pub and club bands. During this time, he was contracted as the composer in residence at an audio post-production studio for TVNZ as well as working as the keyboard technician for tour theatre productions including the NZ tour of Cats. Steven continued his involvement in the world of musical theatre playing in orchestras, managing productions, direction, musical direction and as a performer on stage. After

seeing the light and crossing the ditch in 2004 Steven has kept himself busy with his involvement in a multitude of community theatre projects. He has musically directed 19 productions, directed 9 shows and enjoyed treading the boards in a wide range of plays, revues and musicals across Southeast Queensland. In the 6 months before COVID stopped everything, Steven musically directed Kinky Boots at Spotlight Theatre Company and A Chorus Line at Beenleigh Theatre Group. Steven is thrilled to have an opportunity to be part of the creative team to bring to life this story of resilience and the strength of community spirit.



Choreographer/Assistant Director: Kaitlin Hague

Kaitlin's passion for dance began early, leading her to graduate with distinction from QUT's Bachelor of Creative Industries in Dance in 2007. She toured with the Queensland Arts Council and performed in various corporate and community settings before discovering her love for teaching dance. In 2014, Kaitlin opened Bayside Dance in Wynnum, which now offers classes in many styles of dance for nearly 600 dancers every week.

Kaitlin has extensive experience working with organizations like the Queensland Performing Arts Centre, Dancetrain Magazine, Wynnum Chamber of Commerce and Artslink Queensland in arts education and project coordination. Since 2020, she has been an examiner for Southern Federation of Dance, assessing students nationwide. Kaitlin also holds a Master of Arts, focusing on ballet talent development, and is currently pursuing a PhD in early specialisation in ballet dancers. Come From Away will be Kaitlin's 16th show with Savoyards.

From our first performance of The Mikado in November 1961 to our most recent productions, Savoyards has produced at least two major musical theatre shows every year, receiving 15 Del Artè Charts recognitions for everything from costume and set design, choreography, venue, and musical theatre production to direction. We are a community based (amateur) company governed and managed completely by volunteers and we enjoy the generosity of many professionals who offer their services at little or no cost simply to encourage theatre in Brisbane. These professionals provide us with expertise in management, marketing, hair, and makeup, set construction, photography and much more. We rehearse at the Imperial Playhouse, Wynnum State High School, Peel Street, Manly and perform in the luxurious theatre of the Iona Performing Arts Complex, 85 North Road, Lindum. To give a well-rounded experience of theatre to our performers we encourage all performers to become active in other aspects of the Society, and while it is not compulsory to become a financial member of the Society to participate, we would also encourage you to consider this, and therefore play a part in shaping and ensuring the future of Savoyards.

About Come From Away

Come from Away is based on the true story of the time when the isolated community of Gander, Newfoundland, played host to the world. What started as an average day in a small town turned into an international sleepover, when 38 planes, carrying thousands of people from around the globe, were diverted to Gander's airstrip on September 11, 2001. Undaunted by culture clashes and language barriers, the people of Gander cheered the stranded travellers with music, an open bar and the recognition that we're all part of a global family.

The show represents many ages, nationalities, religions, queer identities, and cultural backgrounds. In doing so, the entire production team places an important focus on representing each person with respect and truth. Accents are accurate and while there are unique and humorous characters, none are presented with irony, satire, or malice. The intention is always to honour the real people and stories represented in the show.

Savoyards is committed to producing theatre that acknowledges and respects the diverse traditions, heritages, and experiences of people in the community. We welcome and celebrate individuals of all backgrounds, identities, and abilities to audition for our productions; inclusive of BIPOC performers, LGBTIQA+ performers, gender diverse performers, and performers with disability. We invite you to bring your authentic self to the audition and join us in creating something extraordinary together.

PRINCIPALS – PRIVATE AUDITION BY APPOINTMENT

Please arrive 15 minutes before your audition to complete the registration process.

Principal audition format -

- 10-minute private individual audition for vocal ability and performance skills.
- Prepare 2 x 60 second song excerpts to show your belt and your upper mix voice. These could even be from one song (i.e. 2 minutes of one song that demonstrates belt and your upper mix range).

Do sing

- With accompaniment (piano or backing),
- In a contemporary and naturalistic style,
- Something that shows strength in your belt range,
- A lyrical piece that demonstrates your upper mix range.

Do not sing


- An obscure folk tune from Newfoundland (which you painstakingly researched).
- Anything operatic in nature,
- An old-fashioned Broadway character song,
- A Hard Rock song with lots of vocal fry,
- A song from the show.
- Your song selection should be about what best demonstrates what your voice can do.
- An accompanist will be available on **Saturday 22nd March 9am 12:30pm** (if required, your audition time will be booked on this Saturday when you register)
- If you are using our accompanist please bring sheet music, properly marked and in a display folder.
- If using backing tracks, bring your backing tracks on an **aux cable ready device**.
- Please prepare 2 contemporary monologues in 2 contrasting accents. These monologues should range from 45 to 60 seconds each in length. It is encouraged that these are committed to memory to support the success of your audition when you are given direction and adjustments. Please note that a catalogue of monologues will be attached to your registration email to support you in finding a suitable piece, however; the creative team encourage you to select from any source material that you feel best demonstrates your versatility as a performer.
- Bring a colour headshot (minimum size 10cm X 15 cm). This will not be returned to you.
- Bring your audition form, completed in full and listing ALL clashes with the show calendar listed in this document.
- There is no movement component during this audition.

Please note that understudy opportunities will be offered in this production. These roles are best suited to performers seeking growth opportunities toward the challenge of learning several roles simultaneously, commonly referred to as a 'swing'. The rehearsal schedule for these roles will be determined by negotiation between the performer and creative team, with the aim of ensuring that the performer is supported with enough time shadowing the principal performers to feel confident in their own ability. Please note that no scheduled performance will be allocated to swings, instead performing any of their assigned tracks with minimal notice in the case of an event preventing the principal performer from going on stage.
